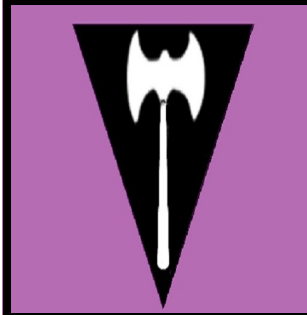




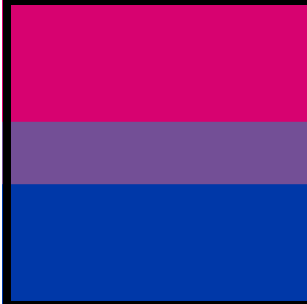
Lipstick Lesbian

Sexual Orientations

Sexual Orientations are very personal and vary from person to person. The information below is simply a general guide to some LGBT community terms. When dealing with these terms it is important to remember that gender identity and sexuality are independent of each other. Some of these terms can be used in a derogatory way and care must be used when speaking to someone about their gender identity. It is always best practice to ask the person which terms they prefer.



Gay

Males who are sexually, romantically or emotionally attracted to other males.

Heterosexuality

Colloquially referred to as being straight. A person who is heterosexual is one who is attracted to people of the opposite gender.

Vapubsexual

Asexuals who are also genitalia repulsed (pronounced vay-pub-sexual) pink is for femininity, blue is for masculinity, red is for passion, white X means lacking.

Lithsexual

A person who experiences sexual attraction but does not desire reciprocation for their attraction.

Fraysexual

A person who has sexual attraction for strangers & acquaintances on a regular basis, but fades once they get to know someone.

Dissociatsexual

A term to describe someone who dissociates on a regular basis during sex and/or sex like activities, often leaving the individual confused with what their sexual attraction is (or lack thereof).

Apothisexual

Someone who is asexual and sex repulsed.

Demisexual

A person who does not feel sexual attraction until a strong emotional bond has been formed.

Autosexual

A person who prefers self gratification over other types of sexual activities.

Abrosexual

An individual that has a fluid and/or rapidly changing sexuality that fluctuates between different sexualities.

Gynephilia

A person that is sexually attracted to women or femininity regardless of their gender identity.

Polysexual

A person whose gender identity is non binary & who is sexually, romantically attracted to others regardless of their gender.

Greysexual

A person who rarely has sexual attraction and/or under very specific circumstances.

Skoliosexual

A person who is sexually and/or romantically attracted to non-binary individuals.

Cupiosexual

Someone who doesn't have sexual attraction but desires a sexual relationship.

Placiosexual

A person wanting to give sexual pleasure to others, but preferably not having it reciprocated.
